

4. Enter your **LOCATION**. If you are not satisfied with the results from the built-in (Google) location search, consider **finding and entering your location's exact latitude and longitude** in decimal degrees (using your phone, a real Google map search or a geographic name authority, like the Getty's TGN: see entry for Rhinecliff: <https://www.getty.edu/vow/TGNFullDisplay?find=rhinecliff&place=&nation=&subjectid=2071899&english=N>)
5. Next, select your **LAYER**. (choose your soundscape's location from *Abu Dis, Annandale-on-Hudson, Saint Petersburg*).

6. Check the following boxes:
 - **Display Panel**
 - **Open Popup.**
7. Click on the **TEXT EDITOR** tab and paste your **iframe** embed code into the editor box.
8. Then, click the **VISUAL EDITOR** tab. You should now see a few small pixels – don't delete this – it is your not-fully rendered SoundCloud embed. Beneath this, write a few sentences that explain the context of the recording.

Scroll to the bottom of the page, you are ready to **PUBLISH** your map marker!
